RE: Executive Summary: April 2026 Aviation Activity Report

El Paso International Airport (ELP) continued to demonstrate stable passenger demand during April 2026 while maintaining a strong regional air service network despite a modest reduction in airline capacity. Through the first four months of 2026, passenger activity has remained essentially flat compared to the same period in 2025, reflecting the airport's continued resilience in a dynamic aviation environment.

Key Highlights

- **Passenger Activity:** The airport served 297,358 passengers in April 2026, a slight decrease of 0.7% compared to April 2025. Year-to-date passenger traffic reached 1.13 million passengers, representing a 0.1% increase over the same period last year, indicating continued stability in overall demand.
- **Air Service:** Airlines operated **51 daily nonstop departures** to destinations across the United States, a reduction of four daily departures from the previous year. Daily seat capacity declined **7.7%**, reflecting industry-wide schedule adjustments rather than a significant decline in passenger demand. Service continues to provide strong connectivity through major airline hubs including Dallas/Fort Worth, Houston, Denver, Phoenix, Atlanta, Chicago, Los Angeles, Seattle, and other key markets.
- **Market Share:** Southwest Airlines remained the airport's largest carrier, serving approximately 49.6% of passengers, followed by American Airlines (25.3%) and United Airlines (13.5%). The airline mix continues to provide

- **Cargo Activity:** Total freight volume increased 8.1% during April compared to the previous year, driven by a significant 21.7% increase in deplaned cargo. Although year-to-date freight volumes remain below 2025 levels, April's growth demonstrates continued strength in cargo operations and the airport's role as an important logistics gateway for the Borderplex region.
- **Aircraft Operations:** Total aircraft operations declined 3.3% in April and 4.4% year-to-date, primarily due to reductions in scheduled air carrier and general aviation activity. Air taxi operations increased 33.4% during the month, partially offsetting decreases in other operational categories and reflecting continued demand for business and charter aviation services.
- **Fuel Flow:** Airport fixed-base operators dispensed approximately 3.48 million gallons of aviation fuel through April 2026, supporting commercial, cargo, military, and general aviation activity at El Paso International Airport.

Overall Assessment

El Paso International Airport continues to maintain a strong operational position. While airline schedules and available seat capacity have moderated compared to 2025, passenger volumes have remained remarkably stable, demonstrating sustained demand for air travel in the El Paso region. Growth in cargo activity and continued service to major domestic markets reinforce the airport's strategic importance as a regional transportation and economic asset. Airport management will continue working with airline partners to identify opportunities for additional air service while supporting initiatives that enhance connectivity, economic development, and customer service.

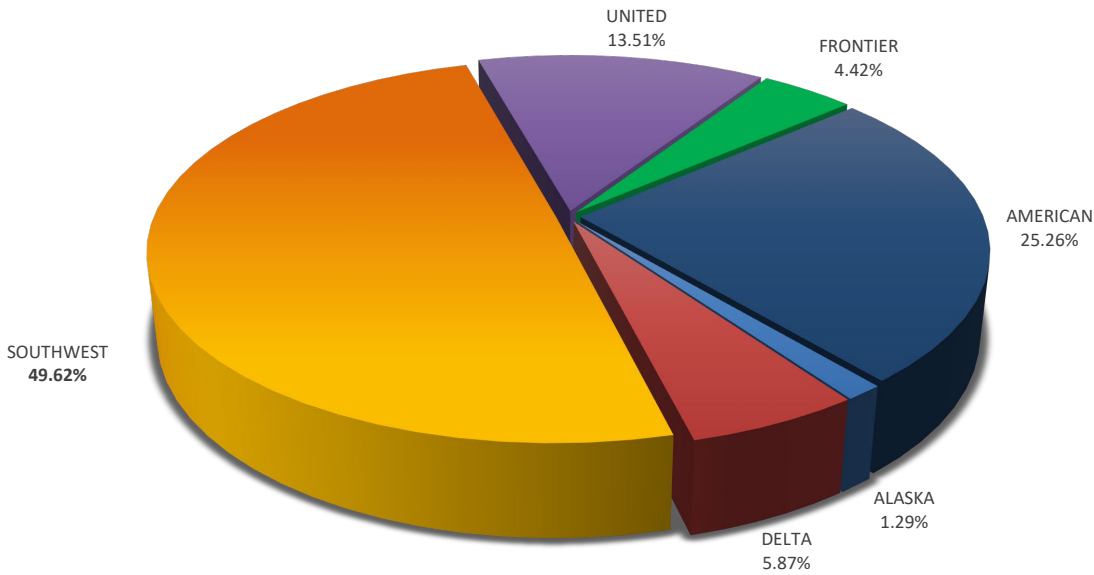

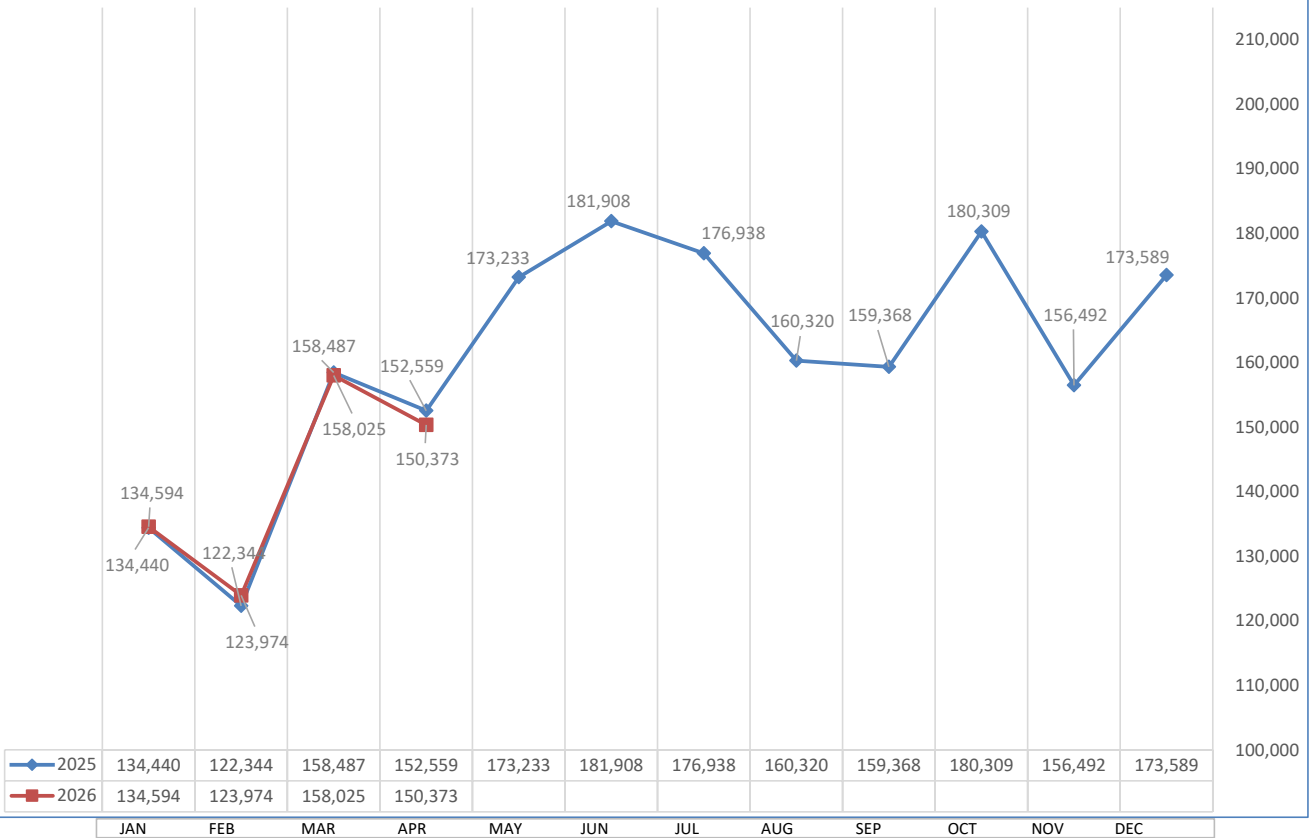


**Orlando - Seasonal Destination*
